

Canada's Anti-Spam Legislation

Canada's Anti-Spam Legislation (CASL) regarding electronic communication came into effect July 1, 2014. This legislation requires that businesses obtain explicit consent from the recipient prior to sending commercial electronic messages. Commercial electronic messages are messages whose purpose is to encourage the recipient to participate in commercial activity. Although we do not necessarily send out messages or letters that directly encourage you to participate in a specific commercial activity, there may be certain components of our correspondence that could be perceived to have an element of commercial activity.
